Dear Friends,

When the Gospel writers sat down to craft their accounts of the life of Jesus they had to select what material they would use. There was a lot to choose from, so much in fact that John says the world wouldn't have room for all the books that would be written if everything Jesus said and did was written down! John's aim in writing his Gospel is to show us that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God. So, he selects material that will serve that aim. He presents us with seven signs and seven sayings of Jesus which, when combined, form a kaleidescope of the glory of God revealed in Jesus. Today we begin a new series exploring these signs and sayings. Let's pray that God opens our eyes to see the glory of Jesus, to believe in him and to have life in his name.




A free phoneline of hymns, reflections and prayers FOODBANK DONATIONS
