Forgive us, Lord, we pray.

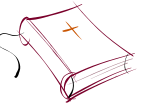
Let us confess the wrong things we have

Amen. Come, Holy Spirit.

perfection in Jesus Christ our Lord;

in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
