RETURN TO LIVE SERVICES

We are delighted to announce that we will be returning to in person services at St James with effect from Sunday 4th July. COVID restrictions will still apply, at least until 19th July, when we hope all remaining restrictions will finally be lifted. All services in July and August will be All Age as we are not in a position to resume children's groups until September. We will not be serving post-service refreshments until the remaining restrictions are lifted, so you are encouraged to bring your own water with you. Sadly, we are not able to run an open creche under current restrictions, so parents of babies and toddlers may want to bring a book or toy for their child. Face masks must be worn by adults in church. Until all remaining restrictions are lifted, numbers who can attend in person will be limited and places must therefore be booked in advance. We will block book places for those volunteering in each service and those not on internet at home, so they will not need to book in advance. That leaves 40 places available for anyone else who wishes to attend. Look out for details of how to book your place in next week's notice sheet. The service will also be livestreamed and available to watch online at home. Details for livestreaming will be published in next week's notice sheet.
