



## CHRISTIANS AGAINST POVERTY (CAP

Paula Thomas has recently finished training as a Debt Coach for CAP. The role involves visiting clients who are in debt in their homes, gathering information about their situation and delivering advice from CAP Debt specialists on routes to help them become debt free. It is also an opportunity to speak to people about Jesus. For safeguarding reasons debt coaches need to be accompanied on their visits by someone from one of the local churches, known as a 'befriender'. Other than accompanying the debt coach the befriender would also become a contact for the client if they needed someone to talk to. The role doesn't require any training and Paula will only be seeing one new client per month so the commitment isn't huge.
